

## ACCELERATE R2 NETWORK CHALLENGE



\$1 Million Challenge to create a *nationwide* network or networks of organizations working to address the nation's most pressing disaster response and resiliency (R2) challenges with innovative technologies. The Accelerate R2 Network Challenge seeks to connect stakeholders in:

<u>**Response innovation**</u> – innovation in the communications, technology, and equipment first responders use when responding to disasters and events

<u>**Resiliency innovation**</u> – finding new ways to build, protect, and connect networks and infrastructure to help communities recover and build readiness and resilience in the face of future disasters

**Potential Applicants Include**: Teams with regional or national connections that have the ability to create and launch a *national network* of R2 stakeholders





What R2 is not

- An R&D project for Response and Resilience
- An EDA RIS grant for a community/region
- A single technology focus or solution; a procurement plan for a community; a technical network
- Directly funding startups or entrepreneurs



- A national coordination effort to align Response and/or Resiliency innovation assets
- Focused on *disaster Response* and/or Resiliency
- A strategic ecosystem and community

#### ACCELERATE R2 NETWORK CHALLENGE \$1 Million Competition

The Accelerate R2 Network Challenge will fund a strategic network of organizations on a national scale working to address disaster Response and Resiliency (R2) challenges with innovative technologies.

Never is the nexus of public safety response and economic impact more prevalent than during a disaster. It is imperative that public safety and local officials have the best tools and technologies to awe lives and help local economics recover and remain resilient into the future.

That's why the Economic Development Administration, in collaboration with the National Institute of Standards and Technology's Public Safety Communications Research division and the First Responder Network Authority, announced the Accelerate R2 Network Challenge.

This \$1 million grant program will sward funds to an organization or organizations to connect stakeholders in the disaster response and resiliency industries across geographics to accelerate the pace at which startups, established comportations, and other organizations bringtechnological innovations to the market. #### There's an opportunity to build, launch, and operate nationwide R2 network that will:

- coordinate accelerator and incubator resources supporting R2 entrepreneurs
- develop and deepen relationships between R2 stakeholders in a peer learning network
- strengthen communication and collaboration between industry, R&D, and govt
- increase commercialization of R2 technologies and increase market access
- serve as industry liaison
- advance technologies used by first responders.







## Must be an eligible entity to apply



- \$1M Federal funds cap for Nationwide R2 Network OR
  \$700K Federal funds cap for Response Network or Resilience Network
  Requires 1:1 match
- Unencumbered, committed, available at the time of application
- In-kind contributions allowable
- No preference given to cash or in-kind



Must present a cohesive strategy to **build and launch a national R2 Network** to connect stakeholders
