ResilienSeed: Underserved Business Incubator

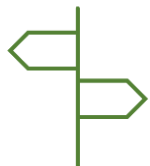

YANA's goal is to decrease periods of disconnection by dividing communication time between close friends and family.



Features:

- Trusted connection creation
- Pre-determined intervals of isolation alerts
- Push messaging cautioning friends and family of potential isolation
- Conversation assessment surveys
- GIS tracking system alerting of potential harmful behaviors (addiction, dangerous landscapes, etc.)

In Step Platform & APP

The In Step psychiatric assessment application is a conduit through which therapeutic interventions for forensic patients are assembled to decrease recidivism

- Allows clinicians to disperse evidenced-based assessments/screenings to patients enhancing efficacy of intervention strategies
- Tracks progression of symptoms, criminogenic risk factors and recidivism rates
- Data analysis and application of AI to predict recidivism factors and triggers
