
Applied research, data analysis, GIS mapping, stakeholder interviews, surveys, etc.

Activities


The UIC UC focuses on green economic development and workforce in the areas of clean energy; green infrastructure; transportation and logistics; and food production and distribution. To better understand changes in the ecosystem and address issues of inclusion and equity, UIC UC conducts outreach, research, dissemination, and technical assistance.

- Outreach: Outreach to stakeholders and partners informs research focus and delivery of technical assistance.
- Research: Research on opportunities for green economic development and workforce capacity is conducted and research results produced.
- Dissemination: Research findings are shared through reports as well as publication on project website; dissemination through social media posts, blog posts, and newsletters; presentations in workshops and forums; etc.
- Technical Assistance (TA): Technical Assistance is provided to community partners and other stakeholders to promote project goals. TA includes everything from identifying resources for businesses to facilitating workforce training and employment opportunities.
