Montana's AgTech Showcase, Innovator Series and Art & Entrepreneurship Series:

AMRII leads events to highlight opportunities and local entrepreneur who are defining what it means to be a start-up in rural Montana.

Entrepreneurial Coaching at Montana's libraries:

Montana public libraries and AMRII have teamed up to train rural librarians on how to be an early stage venture coach and support very early stage entrepreneurs.
