By providing the necessary resources and support systems for our community, the CIC is committed to helping entrepreneurs create successful "scalable enterprises" that have the potential to reach national and/or international markets.

Resources and Services

The CIC assists aspiring, early stage, and/or existing entrepreneurs in the ideation, development, and acceleration of new business ventures by providing a range of business development services including access to capital. Services include *ideation programs*, networking events, an entrepreneur in residence, business and idea competitions, business plan assistance, customer discovery program for STEM, cloud-based software for financial forecasting, pitch training, marketing, and legal assistance, as well as a co-working space.
